Fluffy daffodils

Made using easy, beginner-friendly stitches, **NICOLA VALIJI'S** soft-to-the-touch flowers are a real treasure. If you're new to knitting, this project is a great starting point – you may even find it helpful to practise the petals using a standard non-fluffy yarn. Try adding wire inside the petals to make them positionable, or even create a whole bouquet for someone who loves the narcissi.

FLUFFY DAFFODILS

trumpet

Make three

Using 4.5mm
needles and Pretty
Peach cast on
four sts

Row 1: (kfb) to

end. Eight sts

Row 2: p

Row 3: rep Row 1.

16 sts

Rows 4-12:

starting with a p
row work in st st
Cast off

petal

Make 15

Using 4.5mm
needles and Fluffy
Yellow cast on
three sts

Row 1: k1, kfb, k1.

Four sts

**Row 2 and every
even-numbered
row:** p

Row 3: k1, (kfb)
twice, k1. Six sts

Row 5: k

Row 7: k2tog, k2,
k2tog. Four sts

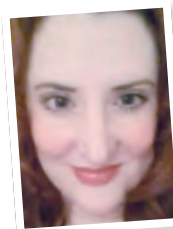
Row 9: (k2tog) to
end. Two sts

Row 10: p

Cast off

to make up

Gather cast-off edge of Trumpet and sew down row edges to top. Place Petals around bottom of Trumpet and sew into place. Weave in all ends
