## Daisy Flower

north west

### Materials:

Use yellow yarn for centre.

White chunky yarn for petals.

7mm crochet hook

### Abbreviations:

mm = millimetres

Ch = chain

S/s = slipstitch

Sk = skip

Dc = double crochet

Tr = treble crochet

Round 1: Using yellow yarn, cast on 6 ch, join with a s/s to 1<sup>st</sup> ch made.

Round 2: 3 ch, 23 tr into ring, join with s/s (24sts)

Fasten off yellow yarn!

Round 3: Using white yarn, 1ch, 1dc into each st. (24sts)

Round 4: \*9ch, 1dc into 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook, 1tr into each of the next 3ch, 1tr into remaining 4ch.

sk next st, s/s into following st,\* (one petal made) Repeat from \* to \* until 12 petals are formed.

S/s to 1<sup>st</sup> ch. (12 petals in total)

Fasten off!

Weave in ends!

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## Forget-Me-Not Flower

(approx 8 inches in diameter, 21cmsch 2, 1dc in base of 2ch, )

### Materials:

Blue chunky yarn for petals

Yellow yarn for centre

7mm crochet hook

### Abbreviations:

mm = millimetre

Ch = chain

S/s = slipstitch

Sp = spaces

Tr2tog = treble 2 stitches together over the next 2 stitches

Tr3tog = treble 3 sts together over the next 3 stitches

Dtr(s)= double treble(s)



Using yellow yarn, chain 4sts, join to 1<sup>st</sup> st with s/s to form a ring

Round 1: chain 5, \*1dtr into ring, 1 ch \* repeat from \* to \* 8 times more, join with s/s to 4<sup>th</sup> ch.

(10 dtrs and 10 ch spaces)

Fasten off yellow yarn.

Each petal is worked individually and crocheted in rows.

Petal, using blue yarn, join to last s/s. Leaving a long joining tail!!

Petal 1.

Row 1: 2ch, 2trs into next ch sp, 2trs into next ch sp 1tr into next st. (6sts) Turn

Row 2: 2ch, 1tr into base of 2ch, 1tr into each of next 4sts, 2trs into last st. (8sts) Turn

Row 3: 2ch, 1tr into base of 2ch, 1tr into each of next 6sts, 2trs into last st. (10sts) Turn

Row 4: 2ch, tr2tog over next 2 sts, 1tr into each st, to last 3sts, tr2tog over next 2 sts, 1tr into last st. (8sts) Turn

Row 5: ch2, tr2tog over next 2 sts, 1tr into each st, to last 3sts, tr2tog over next 2 sts, 1tr into last st. (6sts) Turn

Row 6: Ch2, Tr3tog over 3sts, tr3tog over last sts.(2sts) Turn

Row 7: tr2tog, Fasten off yarn

2nd Petal

Re-join yarn, leaving a long tail, to same place as last tr in row 1. (underlined)

Work as for Petal one.

Continue in this manner until all 5 petals are completed.

Using long tail, left at start of each petal, sew first and second row of each petal together (This will shorten the petal, but will also give the flower a 3d effect).

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## Violet Flower

### Materials:

Chunky yarn, in Yellow, Lilac and Purple  
7mm crochet hook

Finished measurement 7-8 inches in diameter

### Abbreviations:

Ch = chain  
S/s = slipstitch  
Dc = double crochet  
Tr = treble  
Dtr = double treble  
Ttr = triple treble

Start here, using yellow yarn.

Round 1: ch6, join with a s/s to form a ring.

Round 2: ch4, 17dtr into ring, join to top of 4<sup>th</sup> ch with a s/s. (18 dtrs)

Fasten off yellow yarn

Round 3: join lilac yarn to previous s/s, ch2, 2trs into next st, 3dtrs into next st, 3ttr into next st, 3dtrs into next st, 2 trs into next st, 1dc in next st, [\*2trs into next st,3dtrs into next st, 3ttrs into next st, 3dtrs into next st, 2trs into next st, 1dc into next st\*] repeat from {\*to \*} once more. (42sts)

Fasten off lilac yarn!

Using purple yarn, rejoin yarn to last s/s

Round 4: 3ch, \*2trs into each of next 2 sts, 2dtrs into each of next 3sts, 2ttrs into each of next 2 sts, 3ttrs into next st, 2ttrs into each of next 2 sts, 2dtrs into each of next 2sts, 2trs into each of next 2 sts, 1dc into next st,\* Repeat from \* to \* twice more, s/s to top of 2ch. (86sts)

Round 5: 1ch, 1dc into each st, join with s/s to 1<sup>st</sup> dc.

Fasten off. Weave in ends.

### Stem:

(approximately 60 inches/ 1.5 meters x 3 inches/8cms)

Using green chunky yarn and 7mm hook,

Row 1: 170ch, 1dc into 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook, 1dc into each ch to end. (169sts) Turn

Row 2;3;4;5;6;7;8;9;10 &11, ch1, 1dc into each st to end. (169sts)

Fasten off yarn! Weave in ends.
