Duck: approx
12cm x 12cm

CLASSIC DUCKY

Give the traditional bathroom favourite a knitty new look

Rows 26–31: starting with a p row work in st st
Row 32 and every even-numbered row: p
Row 33: (k2, k2tog) to end. 21 sts
Row 35: (k1, k2tog) to end. 14 sts
Row 37: (k2tog) to end. Seven sts
Cut yarn leaving a long tail, thread tail onto tapestry needle and thread through rem sts, fasten off

BEAK
Using 4.5mm needles and Sandy Yellow cast on 14 sts
Row 1: k3, p1, k6, p1, k3
Row 2: p3, k1, p6, k1, p3
Row 3: k1, k2tog, p1, k2tog, k2, k2tog, p1, k2tog, k1. Ten sts
Row 4: p2, k1, p4, k1, p2
Row 5: k2tog, p1, (k2tog) twice, p1, k2tog. Six sts
Cut yarn leaving a long tail, thread tail onto tapestry needle and thread through rem sts, fasten off



No matter what age you are, rubber ducky can't help but instantly bring back memories of splashing around in the bathtub as a kid. If you're still a fan, and there's no shame in that, why not whip one up with your Sunshine yarn kit and **ELLA AUSTIN'S** lovely pattern? Featuring only one simple increase and decrease, it is the perfect introduction to shaping techniques for new knitters.

rubber ducky

Using 4.5mm needles and Shell White cast on 20 sts
Row 1: [(kfb) twice, k5, (kfb) twice, k1] to end. 28 sts

Row 2 and every even-numbered row: p
Row 3: k1, * kfb, k1, kfb, k5, kfb, k1, kfb*, k3, rep from * to * once, k2. 36 sts
Row 5: (k2, kfb) twice, (k5, kfb, k2, kfb) three times,

k3. 44 sts
Row 7: (k3, kfb) twice, k5, kfb, k3, kfb, k7, kfb, k3, kfb, k5, kfb, k3, kfb, k4. 52 sts
Rows 8–10: starting with a p row work in st st
Row 11: k20, kfb, k8, kfb, k to end. 54 sts
Rows 12–14: rep Rows 8–10
Row 15: k4, k2tog,

k14, k2tog, k1, k2tog, k4, k2tog, k1, k2tog, k14, k2tog, k4. 48 sts
Row 16 and every even-numbered row: p
Row 17: k3, k2tog, k10, (k2tog, k1) twice, k2tog, k2, (k2tog, k1) twice, k2tog, k10, k2tog, k3. 40 sts
Row 19: cast off 12 sts, k to end. 28 sts

Row 20: cast off 12 sts, p to end. 16 sts
Rows 21–22: starting with a k row work in st st
Row 23: (k1, kfb) three times, k3, (kfb, k1) twice, kfb, k2. 22 sts
Row 24: p
Row 25: (k2, kfb) three times, k3, (kfb, k2) twice, kfb, k3. 28 sts

TO MAKE UP
Sew Head and back of Body tog. Stuff. Sew tog along base. Sew bottom of Beak tog, stuffing lightly. Holding Beak flat with purl sts at sides, sew to front of Head so seam is at bottom. Sew in ends. Embroider two eyes in Ocean Blue on Head
